What is 23g?

These funds are designated to support students before, during and after school to address unfinished learning. These funds are targeted toward students who may fall behind their peers in grade level standards.

Implementation of funds:

CAPS will use funds to enhance evidence based instructional practices in tier 1 instruction and tier 2. The goal is to provide training on essential standards and a guaranteed and viable curriculum to all students. The students will be given additional instructional support with current teaching staff and or paraprofessional.

CAPS will use funds to support where identified student tier 1, 2 and 3 academic and behavior, coaching for staff. The grant may fund coaches for instructional purposes on essential standards and modeling effective teaching/behavior practices. Also, this specialized staff needed to support students in gaining additional instruction for support both behavior and academic measures.

CAPS will use a data set to identify all students behind in academic and or behavior achievement. This may also require support staff to prepare accurate reporting, tracking, progress monitoring reports.

CAPS 23g Reporting measures

Program measures are based on NWEA, local assessment, M-STEP, and other diagnostic measures used in reading and math.

Monitoring will consist of District and school reports.

CAPS will comply with all reporting requirements, both state and federal.
