This opportunity is available because of an agreement between the Michigan Department of Education and Michigan State University. The credits can be used toward a bachelor’s degree or undergraduate certificate program at MSU. Imagine coming to college with six credits! Your hard work in high school will be rewarded!

## **Who is eligible?**

Michigan high school students who have completed the state-approved Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources Education Program in their schools and have received the State FFA degree are eligible.

## **How are credits applied?**

To apply the credits to an MSU degree or program, students need to work with their departmental advisors to determine how the credits will count.
